Medrix was a recipient of Rotary Club's support in Safe Water and we would like to give you an update. MEDRIX training courses and heart surgery grants for children who need life saving heart surgeries.

MEDRIX, is an acronym for Medical, Education, Development of Resources and International Exchange. MEDRIX is a 501-c-3 and an International Non-government organization registered in Vietnam. MEDRIX is an all-volunteer organization. The MEDRIX home office is in Redmond, with a field office in Vietnam. Incorporated in April 2000. MEDRIX has been serving the people of Vietnam since that time. Robert is a Meteorologists by education and LaRelle is a nurse educator. They live in Woodinville, and are the parents of two adult sons, and 5 (nearly) adult grandchildren and one slightly eccentric dog named Einstein. Robert enjoys coffee, gardening vegetables and berries, riding his motorcycle on the back roads of the local area, and eating maple bars. He attends one class a quarter at the University of Washington - usually in an area of GIS mapping, geology or other fields that will lend to his work "Open Source GIS" for Scientific Mapping in Vietnam. He also teaches at the University of Science and Technology in Hue, Vietnam.

LaRelle on the other hand loves nursing and advancing the nursing care in Vietnam to meet global standards. She has taught for nursing schools at Shoreline, Seattle Pacific University, Northwest University and Azusa Pacific. Her specialty is in patient advocacy (particularly for children of vulnerable populations) and policy development for Vietnam hospitals. She loves gardening design and flowers, warm weather, scenic water sights and cinnamon rolls. Einstein is her constant companion when she is home.

In the summer of 2005, Dr. Tony Brooks was a member of the vaunted and secretive 75th Ranger Regiment in Afghanistan. On the very first mission of his career, he was tasked with the rescue and recovery of a downed chinook helicopter carrying 16 service members and a missing 4 man Navy SEAL reconnaissance team that included the Lone Survivor. For the first time, Dr. Tony Brooks will share the story of the 75th Ranger Regiment in this storied rescue with our local community. 
